AWFiS offers candidates the following majors in English

Physical Education – Ist and IInd cycle (the second-cycle of master's studies is available for bachelor's graduates of Physical Education) (2 700 euro for a year of study)

Management in Sport - IInd-cycle (2 700 euro for a year of study)

Tourism and Recreation - Ist and IInd cycle (2 700 euro for a year of study)

A candidate who wants to pass the recruitment process successfully must submit the following documents:

- 1. **Application for enrollment** at University application for studies with the choice of the field of study this application is addressed to the Rector of the University.
- 2. **Register Form** candidate data with the choice of the field of study

At the next stage, the University sends the candidate following documents:

- 3. **Invitation** Invitation for studying- the invitation is individual for each candidate.
- 4. The university sends the candidate the **INVOICE** *pro forma* to pay for the studies .The candidate has two weeks to transfer money for the year of study to the indicated EURO account number. At this point, the candidate is required to pay 2,700 euros tuition for one academic year of studies. The head of the education department, on behalf of the University, checks the payment, if it exists in the bank.
- 5. Letter of Acceptance / CERTIFICATE a certificate of admission of a foreigner to the university for studies. At this point, the candidate applies for a visa.

The candidate who will come to study is obliged to bring the following documents with them and submit the documents to the room no. 105 immediately upon arrival:

- confirmation of payment for studies,
- headshot photo on a signed CD,
- medical certificate from the doctor of labor the certificate should be printed from the AWFiS website and the candidate should make a doctors' appointment at a chosen medical facility in Poland. The cost of the doctor's visit would about 70 -100 PLN.
- insurance policy in case of illness or unfortunate accident for the period of education in Poland,
- a photocopy of the passport, visa, residence card or any other document entitling you to stay on the territory of the Republic of Poland,
- document confirming the knowledge of English if there is one
- for first-cycle legalized or signed with an apostille* secondary school-leaving examination certificate or any other document entitling them to apply for admission to universities of any type in the country where there is a system of certifying authority, recognized in accordance with provisions of the nostrification of school-related certificates and secondary school-leaving certificates obtained abroad as an equivalent of the relevant Polish secondary school-leaving certificate,
- for the 2nd-cycle studies the diploma of higher education entitling to take up the second-cycle studies legalized and recognized in accordance with nostrification regulations.

All documents should be translated into Polish and English by a sworn translator whose name is entered on the list of sworn translators kept by the Minister of Justice or by a foreign translator and then certified by the Polish Consul.

IMPORTANT NOTICE! The candidate is obliged to bring the original school-leaving certificates with them to POLAND.
